



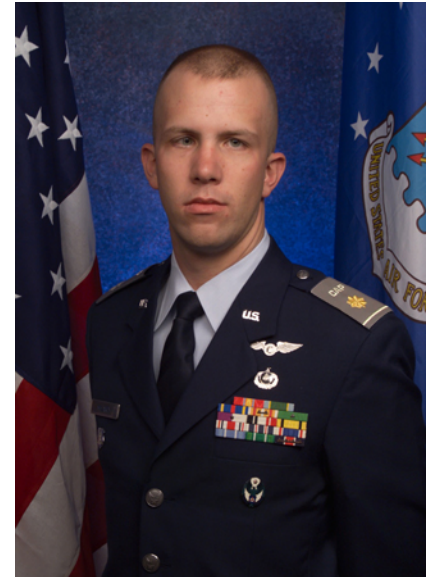

As director of information technology, he manages and directs all information technology related activities at the wing level.

Major McLarty joined Civil Air Patrol as a cadet in September 1997, achieving the grade of Cadet Technical Sergeant prior to entering the Civil Air Patrol senior program as the assistant director of cadet programs for Texas Wing in 1998.
